A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN OPEN-END EQUITY LEASE AGREEMENT WITH ENTERPRISE FLEET MANAGEMENT FOR TEN NEW CHEVROLET WORK TRUCKS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has advised this Council that the Department of Public Service is in need of ten (10) new heavy duty work trucks and is recommending the City enter into an open-end lease agreement for such vehicles;

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Richmond Heights provides that this Council may authorize purchases exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars without public competitive bidding where the City is participating in cooperative purchasing programs of political subdivisions, and Sourcewell is a local government unit, corporation and public agency under the laws of the state of Minnesota which awarded a competitively bid contract for fleet management services to Enterprise Fleet Management;

WHEREAS, the Service Director has obtained a quote from Enterprise Fleet Management for an open-end equity lease for eight (8) new 2023 Chevrolet Silverado 2500 Heavy Duty 4x4 double cab work trucks for twelve (12) months and two (2) new 2023 Chevrolet Silverado 3500 Heavy Duty 4x4 work trucks for twenty-four (24) months at the cooperative purchasing price for fleet management services under Sourcewell contract #060618-EFM in the amount of \$696.27 monthly rental for 12 months for each of the eight 2500 model trucks, including a \$395 service charge due at lease termination for each truck, for a total cost not to exceed Seventy Thousand One Dollar and Ninety-Two Cents (\$70,001.92), and in the amount of \$979.25 monthly rental for 24 months for each of the two 3500 model trucks, including a \$395.00 service charge per truck due at lease termination, for a total cost not to exceed Forty-Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Four Dollars (\$47,794.00) for a total monthly lease and service fee amount not to exceed One Hundred Seventeen Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars and Ninety-Two Cents (\$117,795.92) for the ten leased vehicles;

WHEREAS, Enterprise has offered to sell the following City Department of Public Service's current fleet of ten (10) vehicles which will be replaced by the new vehicles, and remit the proceeds of the sale of the vehicles to the City, less a service charge of \$395.00 per vehicle, which shall be deducted from the proceeds:

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Finance Committees have reviewed the need for this proposed lease and agreement to sell the City's current fleet vehicles which are to be replaced and recommend the same to Council, and Council desires to authorize a lease from Enterprise Fleet Management of eight (8) new 2023 Chevy Silverado 2500 Heavy Duty 4x4 double cab work trucks for twelve (12) months, and two (2) new 2023 Chevy Silverado 3500 Heavy Duty 4x4 work trucks for twenty-four (24) months, subject to annual appropriation by Council, at a total cost not to exceed \$117,795.92, and to authorize an agreement with Enterprise Fleet Management for the sale of the City's current fleet vehicles which are to be replaced, and the payment of a service charge of \$395.00 per vehicle sold, which shall be deducted from the proceeds of the sales remitted to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an open-end equity lease agreement with Enterprise Fleet Management for eight (8) new 2023 Chevrolet Silverado 2500 Heavy Duty 4x4 double cab work trucks for twelve (12) months and two (2) new 2023 Chevrolet Silverado 3500 Heavy Duty 4x4 work trucks for twenty-four (24) months for the Service Department, in an amount not to exceed \$117,795.92 and to enter into an agreement with Enterprise Fleet Management for the sale of ten (10) of the City's fleet vehicles identified in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account the amount of Seventy Thousand One Dollar and Ninety-Two Cents (\$70,001.92) for the lease agreement for the eight (8) new 2023 Chevrolet Silverado 2500 Heavy Duty 4x4 double cab work trucks for the twelve-month lease agreement, and shall appropriate the amount of Twenty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Two Dollars (\$23,502.00) for the first year of the twenty-four month lease agreement for the two (2) new 2023 Chevrolet Silverado 3500 Heavy Duty 4x4 work trucks.


Section 3: This Council finds that the ten (10) current fleet vehicles authorized to be sold in Section 1 of this Resolution are either obsolete or are not needed or unfit for public use.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
