A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GREAT AMERICAN FIDELITY INSURANCE COMPANY FOR A RISK e-BUSINESS CYBER LOSS & LIABILITY INSURANCE POLICY.

WHEREAS, the City's insurance agent and risk manager under the Northern Ohio Risk Management Association (NORMA), Wichert Insurance, has procured necessary cyber loss and liability insurance for the City on a one-year basis for a premium of \$5,502.00.

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into the foregoing insurance agreement as a necessary insurance coverage for this prevalent risk to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an insurance agreement with Great American Fidelity Insurance Company for a cyber loss and liability insurance policy for one year for a premium cost of Five Thousand Five Hundred Two Dollars (\$5,502.00).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




