

RESOLUTION NO.: 80-2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH DAMSCHRODER ROOFING INC. FOR THE COMMUNITY CENTER (LODGE) ROOF REPLACEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City provided Invitations to Bid for the Community Center (Lodge) Roof Replacement Project (the "Project") to five (5) contractors at their request:

WHEREAS, one (1) competitive bid was received by the City in response to the Invitation to Bid for the Project, with such work to be performed in accordance with the specifications prepared therefor and on file with the City;

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid received for the Project was the bid of Damschroder Roofing Inc. in the amount of \$228,471, which includes Alternate #1 at a cost of \$19,507;

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded a federal Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") through the Cuyahoga County Municipal Grant Program for this Project in the amount of \$150,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Damschroder Roofing Inc. for the Community Center (Lodge) Roof Replacement Project in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Three Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$251,312), which includes a contingency allowance not to exceed 10% of the contract bid amount.




Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
