A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO COMMUNITY COST-SHARE AGREEMENTS WITH THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT FOR STORMWATER RELATED WORK AND EXPENDITURES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 13-2016, passed April 12, 2016, the City of Richmond Heights entered into a Regional Stormwater Management Program Service Agreement with Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORSD);

WHEREAS, as part of the Regional Stormwater Management Program, NEORSD manages a Community Cost Share account which provides funding to assist the City with District-approved projects;

WHEREAS, the District has approved the City's Euclid Creek Watershed Program – Dues Project, in the amount of \$3,000; the Non-NEORSD Area-CCBH Services Project, in the amount of \$3,364; and the Richmond Heights Storm Water Management Program Project, in the amount of \$35,000, as Community Cost Share projects, and the District will allocate the total sum of \$41,364 in Community Cost Share funds for these expenditures and work; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into Community Cost-Share Agreements with NEORSD so that Community Cost-Share funds can be utilized for the City's work and expenditures described above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into Community Cost-Share Agreements with NEORSD to receive the total sum of \$41,364 in Community Cost-Share funds to use for the City's Euclid Creek Watershed Program – Dues Project, the Non-NEORSD Area-CCBH Services Project, and the Richmond Heights Storm Water Management Program Project, which shall include such terms as are acceptable to the Director of Law.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
