A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A WILDFIRE COMMUNITY
PREPAREDNESS DAY GRANT FROM THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION
ASSOCIATION AND STATE FARM INSURANCE.

WHEREAS, through the efforts of the Division of Fire, particularly through the efforts of Firefighter Richard Rousch, the City has been awarded a National Fire Protection Association and State Farm Insurance "Wildfire Community Preparedness Day" grant in the amount of \$500.00 for the purpose of supporting a wildfire risk reduction project in the City of Richmond Heights;

WHEREAS, by this Resolution the City expresses its desire to accept the grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to accept the grant set forth in the preamble to this Resolution on behalf of the City and is authorized to take all actions necessary to support the Wildfire Community Preparedness Day campaign for this Grant.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
