

RESOLUTION NO.: 47-2020

**A RESOLUTION RATIFYING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO, AN AGREEMENT WITH COLLINS EQUIPMENT CORP. TO PERFORM EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO THE CITY'S VEHICLE FUELING STATION.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to §131.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Richmond Heights, the Mayor is authorized to enter into and to execute on behalf of the City all contracts for services, goods, materials and supplies in an amount not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) for each contract, provided that the necessary appropriation therefor has been made by the Council and the Director of Finance attaches to each contract a fiscal officer's certificate as required by the Charter and state law;

WHEREAS, the Mayor contracted with Collins Equipment Corp. for emergency repairs to the City's vehicle fueling station to keep City vehicles running to provide City services in the amount of three thousand seven hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$3,797.00);

WHEREAS, during excavation for repairs at the fueling station site it was discovered that additional repairs would be necessary to complete the work, which resulted in additional costs, bringing the total cost for the emergency repairs to six thousand three hundred five dollars (\$6,305.00);

WHEREAS, this Council desires to ratify and authorize the Mayor entering into an agreement with Collins Equipment Corp. in the amount of six thousand three hundred five dollars (\$6,305.00) for emergency repairs to the City's vehicle fueling station;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: This Council hereby ratifies and authorizes the Mayor entering into an agreement with Collins Equipment Corp. in the amount of six thousand three hundred five dollars (\$6,305.00) for emergency repairs to the City's vehicle fueling station.


SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.
