A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A CORONAVIRUS EMERGENCY
SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING GRANT FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF
PUBLIC SAFETY'S OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, through the efforts of the Division of Police, particularly through the grant writing skills and efforts of Sergeant Todd Leisure, the City has been awarded a 2020 Coronavirus Supplemental Emergency Funding Grant ("Grant") in the amount of \$2,965.56 for the purpose of acquiring additional cleaning supplies and personal protective equipment necessary to protect the City's law enforcement officers against the spread of the novel coronavirus;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to accept the Grant set forth in the recitals above from the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services on behalf of the City and is authorized to take all actions necessary to assure the acquisition of cleaning supplies and personal protective equipment necessary to combat the spread of the novel coronavirus.


Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
