A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH C.A. AGRESTA  
CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR THE  
COMMUNITY PARK SWALE RETROFIT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, three quotations were received by the City for labor and materials for the storm water swale retrofit project at the Community Park (the "Project") with such work to be performed in accordance with the specifications prepared therefor by the City Engineer and on file with the City;

WHEREAS, the City Engineer advises that the lowest and best quotation received for the labor and materials for Sections I and II of the Project was the quotation of C.A. Agresta Construction Company in the amount of \$34,716;

WHEREAS, the City will be reimbursed for the full amount of the cost of this Project from Cuyahoga County and from the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District Community Cost-Share program;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: A contract with C.A. Agresta Construction Company is authorized for labor and materials for Sections I and II of the Community Park Retrofit Project in an amount not to exceed \$34,716 and the City administration shall take all necessary steps to obtain the reimbursement for the total cost of the Project from Cuyahoga County and the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
