A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DONATION FROM RICHMOND HEIGHTS RESIDENT SAMUEL JOHNSON OF MULTIPLE DRONES TO THE DIVISION OF POLICE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS AND EXPRESSING APPRECIATION TO MR. JOHNSON.

WHEREAS, Samuel Johnson, a resident of Richmond Heights, has donated multiple drones and parts to the Richmond Heights Division of Police for use in its Cop Scouts program and/or other youth outreach and activities;

WHEREAS, the donated drones consist of a total of seventeen (17) drones and a box of miscellaneous drone parts with an approximate value of \$500, as follows:

- (4) R/C Quadcopter Drones-All black
- (4) HDRC Hunters 2.4 GHz R/C 6 Axis Gyro Quadcopter-(3) black & (1) red
- (6) HDRC 6-Axis Gyro R/C Drone with camera-(3) white & (3) black
- (1) Small drone (Unknown model)-White & black
- (1) Fulaiying Toys Drone-Black
- (1) Toys-Sky GPS Drone with camera-Black
- (1) Box of drone replacement parts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


