Polls open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 7:30 p.m. The Cuyahoga County Board of Elections recently announced a new voting location for Ward 1, which will now vote at Christian Assembly, located at 25595 Chardon Road in Richmond Heights. Ward 2 votes at the Kiwanis Lodge, 27285 Highland Road, in the back of Richmond Heights Community Park. Ward 3 will vote at Saint Gregory of Narek Church at 678 Richmond Road. Lastly, Ward 4 votes at Richmond Heights Church of the Nazarene at 499 Trebisky Road.
