DRIVE THRU FOOD PANTRY AT MACE ISLAMIC CENTER

May 28th from 5:00 pm – 6:30 pm at 26901 Chardon Road, Richmond Heights, Ohio 44143 Due to COVID 19 Pandemic, there will be drive-through service. Food will be delivered to your car in compliance with social distancing recommendations. MACE hosts a Food Pantry, in partnership with the Greater Cleveland Food Bank, every 4th Thursday of the month. All food distributed is provided by the Food Bank and is open to all. The only requirement to be served is to bring your ID. Please pass the word to those in need.

PANDEMIC ELECTRONIC BENEFIT TRANSFER (P-EBT)

The Ohio Dept. of Job and Family Services is partnering with the Ohio Dept. of Education to provide families with children in kindergarten through twelfth grade, that have been eligible for free or reduced-price meals with temporary Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits to help with the cost of nutritious meals. Families do not need to apply for the P-EBT benefits.

SIMPLE RECYCLING RETURNING TO RICHMOND HEIGHTS

The City of Richmond Heights partners with [Simple Recycling](#), which offers a curbside pickup recycling program at absolutely zero cost to partner municipalities and their residents. Just use the provided orange “Simple Recycling” bags to recycle unwanted clothing and housewares in re-usable condition and place the bags at the curb a minimum of 3 feet away from your trash cart on your normal trash pickup day each Monday.

BEWARE OF COVID-19 HEALTH AGENCY SCAMS

While legitimate health agencies, including the Cuyahoga County Board of Health and the Cleveland Department of Public Health are calling people to complete contact tracing, ***they will never ask for your Social Security or Bank Account information. COVID-19 EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

Emergency Assistance is temporarily available for families affected by COCID-19, through the Prevention, Retention, and Contingency (PRC) program with Temporary Assistance for the Needy Families (TANF) funding.
