SIMPLE RECYCLING RETURNING TO RICHMOND HEIGHTS

The City of Richmond Heights partners with [Simple Recycling](#), which offers a curbside pickup recycling program at absolutely zero cost to partner municipalities and their residents. Just use the provided orange "Simple Recycling" bags to recycle unwanted clothing and housewares in

re-usable condition and place the bags at the curb a minimum of 3 feet away from your trash cart on your normal trash pickup day each Monday.
