

RESOLUTION NO.: 152 -2022

INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Thomas and All of Council

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH PFUND SUPERIOR SALES CO., INC. THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR A NEW EMERGENCY AMBULANCE VEHICLE FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE UTILIZING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Council has authorized cooperative purchasing through the competitive bids obtained by the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Fire has requested and the Council's Safety Committee has recommended the purchase of a 2023 Ford E-450 Life Line "Custom Superliner" type III ambulance, the purchase of which can be made through the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program utilizing local recovery funds distributed through Cuyahoga County under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds;

WHEREAS, Council's Committees have reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommend the same and this Council desires to authorize the procurement of this ambulance through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program from Pfund Superior Sales Co., Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement for one new ambulance, that being a 2023 Ford E-450 Life Line "Custom Superliner" type III ambulance, from Pfund Superior Sales Co., Inc. at a cost not to exceed the amount of \$245,000.00, under State Schedule Contract Vendor No. 800217, as part of the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program utilizing local recovery funds distributed from Cuyahoga County under ARPA.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to expend funds from Fund 224-Cuyahoga County-ARPA in the amount deemed necessary to cover the cost for the purchase of the equipment as set forth in Section 1 above.


