A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT
FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND
AUTHORIZING MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE CITY.

WHEREAS, through the efforts of the Division of Fire, particularly through the grant writing skills and efforts of Lieutenant Jason Buss, the City has been awarded a U.S. Department of Homeland Security "Assistance to Firefighters Grant" in the amount of \$78,400 for the purpose of purchasing two (2) cardiac monitors/defibrillators with extended service and maintenance agreements for the Division of Fire;

WHEREAS, the grant requires a five percent (5%) match by the City which will total \$3,733.34 of the \$78,400.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to accept the Grant set forth in the preamble to this Resolution on behalf of the City and is authorized to take all actions necessary to assure the Department of Homeland Security of the five percent (5%) match of \$3,733.34 for this grant.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is directed to appropriate to a proper account the amount of \$3,733.34 as the required match to accept the within Grant.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
