

RESOLUTION NO.: 145-2023

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF A VEHICLE
THAT IS UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE AND UNFIT FOR CITY
PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service and Properties has recommended the disposal and discarding of the City's 1988 C70 GMC boom truck, which failed its inspection and must be scrapped according to Delta Mobile Testing Company, which truck had been previously used by the Department of Public Service and Properties, but which is now unneeded, obsolete and unfit for municipal purposes;

WHEREAS, Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for the discarding of such municipal personal property, including vehicles, by authorization of this City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service and Properties is authorized to dispose of and discard the City's 1988 GMC C70 boom truck, VIN # 1GDL7D1B5JV500607, as described in the recitals above as being unneeded, obsolete and unfit for City purposes.




Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
