A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 139-2023 TO REVISE THE FUND FROM WHICH PAYMENT WILL COME FOR AN AGREEMENT WITH CT CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE CITY'S NEW SERVICE DEPARTMENT FACILITY PROJECT.

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2023, this Council adopted Resolution No. 139-2023 authorizing an agreement with CT Consultants, Inc. to provide professional design services for the City's New Service Department Facility Project (the "Project") for a total lump sum fee of \$52,840.00 which payment was to come from the City's local fiscal recovery ARPA funds;

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has requested that the funds for payment of the foregoing agreement instead come from the Department of Public Service and Property's Capital Improvement FY 2023 budget, Account No. 201-6450-54900.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: Resolution No. 139-2023 of this Council is hereby amended to provide that the authorized amount of Fifty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Forty Dollar (\$52,840.00) for design services from CT Consultants, Inc. for the aforesaid Project shall come from the Department of Public Service and Property's Capital Improvement FY 2023 budget, Account No. 201-6450-54900.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code,


Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
