A Resolution Recognizing the Retirement of Richmond Heights Lieutenant Bernard Joseph Schweter

Whereas

After serving with the Richmond Heights Division of Fire for more than thirty (30) years, Lieutenant Bernard Joseph Schweter retired on February 1, 2024;

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Schweter was hired on January 1, 1994, and following that hiring has served as a Lieutenant Paramedic and received numerous letters of commendation and gratitude for his service to the City and its citizens;

WHEREAS, during his over 30 years of service, Lieutenant Schweter made a positive difference in countless lives, both in the City of Richmond Heights and in the region;

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Schweter has exhibited such dedication in his public service that Mayor Thomas and this Council desire to recognize him for his service to the City and to the community at large;

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Schweter earned an Associate's degree in Applied Science in E.M.S. from Cuyahoga Community College, a Bachelor's degree and a Master's degree in Business Administration from Tiffin University, and a Ph.D. in Organizational Leadership from Capella University;

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Schweter served as regional faculty for the American Heart Association and as an educator for Cuyahoga Community College, teaching E.M.S. throughout his tenure;
