A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF DIVISION OF FIRE VEHICLE INVENTORY CONSISTING OF A 2012 FORD F-450 “LIFELINE” AMBULANCE, WHICH IS OBSOLETE, UNNEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, AND OUT OF SERVICE, TO BE TRADED FOR AN ALLOWANCE/CREDIT WITH AUBURN CAREER CENTER TRAINING GROUNDS FOR FIREFIGHTER TRAINING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Division of Fire desires to trade in its 2012 Ford F-450 “Lifeline” Ambulance for a credit with Auburn Career Center for the cost of firefighter training services;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Fire has advised this Council that the ambulance is obsolete, unneeded for public use and is out of service for any emergency responses;

WHEREAS, Auburn Career Center has offered a trade-in value of \$5,000 for the used ambulance in the form of a credit of \$5,000 to be expended toward use of its facilities, including live burning building, instructors, and fire service curricula for firefighter training services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council finds that the ambulance at issue is obsolete, unneeded for public/municipal use and should continue to be out of service for any emergency responses.

Section 2: The Mayor is authorized to execute all documents necessary to transfer ownership of the following vehicle to Auburn Career Center in exchange for a credit of \$5,000.00 for firefighter training services for the City’s Division of Fire at its facility:
