

RESOLUTION NO.: 178-2024

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF EQUIPMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND PROPERTIES THAT IS UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE AND UNFIT FOR CITY PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has recommended the disposal and discarding of City equipment once used by the Department of Public Service and Properties – i.e., a trailer which was used for hauling equipment to job sites – and which is unneeded, obsolete and unfit for municipal purposes;

Whereas, Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for the discarding of such equipment by authorization of this City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service and Properties is authorized to dispose and discard the trailer that has been used to transport equipment to and from job sites (as shown in the photo attached hereto as Exhibit A) as being unneeded, obsolete and unfit for City purposes.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
