A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A BID FOR THE HARRIS ROAD - HARMS ROAD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT THEREFOR WITH COOK PAVING & CONSTRUCTION CO., INC.

WHEREAS, pursuant to legal notice therefor, duly published according to law, six (6) sealed bids were received at the office of the Purchasing Agent of the City of Richmond Heights for labor and materials for the Harris Road – Harms Road Drainage Improvements Project in accordance with specifications prepared by the City Engineer and on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent;

WHEREAS, pursuant thereto, the lowest and best bid received for said labor and materials for the Harris Road – Harms Road Drainage Improvements Project, as recommended by the City Engineer, is:

Cook Paving & Construction Co, Inc. in the amount of \$102,767.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The bid for labor and materials for the Harris Road – Harms Road Drainage Improvements Project by Cook Paving & Construction Co, Inc. in the amount of \$102,767.00, as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution, is accepted by this Council as the lowest and best bid therefor and the Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized to execute the contract in accordance with this Council's appropriation therefor.

Section 2: The funds necessary for payment of the contract authorized in Section 1 hereof shall come from Fund# 440-5450-52106.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
