A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND (WPCLF) AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF WASTEWATER FACILITIES; AND DESIGNATING A DEDICATED REPAYMENT SOURCE FOR THE LOAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights seeks to upgrade its existing wastewater facilities by constructing the ~~NEORSD Sanitary Sewer Project~~; *Richmond Heights Sewer Capacity Improvement*

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights intends to apply for Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) funding for the construction of the wastewater facilities;

WHEREAS, the WPCLF requires the government authority to pass legislation for the application of a loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to apply for a WPCLF loan, sign all documents for and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for construction of wastewater facilities on behalf of the City of Richmond Heights, Ohio, that being the ~~NEORSD Sanitary Sewer Project~~ *Richmond Heights Sewer Capacity Improvement*

SECTION 2. The dedicated source of repayment will be the City of Richmond Heights Sewer Improvement Fund Number 450-8000-48106.


