A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A BID FOR THE EARTHWORK FOR THE PUBLIC SERVICE DEPARTMENT SALT STORAGE BUILDING PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT THEREFOR WITH CMG CONSTRUCTION, LLC.

WHEREAS, pursuant to legal notice therefor, duly published according to law, four (4) sealed bids were received at the office of the Purchasing Agent of the City of Richmond Heights for labor and materials for the earthwork necessary for the Richmond Heights Public Service Department Salt Storage Building Project in accordance with Solicitation for Competitive Bids on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent;

WHEREAS, pursuant thereto, the lowest and best bid received for said earthwork for the Richmond Heights Service Department Salt Storage Building Project, as recommended by the Director of Public Service and Properties, is:

CMG Construction, LLC in the amount of \$134,740.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The bid for the earthwork necessary for the Richmond Heights Public Service Department Salt Storage Building Project by CMG Construction, LLC in the amount of \$134,740.00, as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution, is accepted by this Council as the lowest and best bid therefor and the Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized to execute the contract in accordance with this Council's appropriation therefor.

Section 2: The funds necessary for payment of the contract authorized in Section 1 hereof shall come from Fund# 401-7150-54360.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
