

RESOLUTION NO.: 93-2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FROM THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS FOR A PROJECT TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR ITS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026.

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Municipal Grant Program is a competitive federal grant program that makes awards to municipalities to help strengthen cities, encourage regional collaboration, and improve quality of life for Cuyahoga County residents;

WHEREAS, the City has been advised by the Cuyahoga County Department of Development that it is eligible to participate in a competitive application process for awarding of Community Development Block Grant funds for Fiscal Year 2026;

WHEREAS, the City is permitted to submit one or more projects as part of its application, provided the aggregate total of the funding does not exceed \$150,000;

WHEREAS, a public hearing related to the City's participation in the Community Development Block Grant Program for Fiscal Year 2025 was held by the City on June 3, 2025;

WHEREAS, the City has determined to apply for said block grant funds to supplement the expenses to make necessary improvements to update the audio/video equipment at the Richmond Heights Community Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The following project to eliminate blight and to enhance City facilities in a "Low to Moderate Income" area of the City is hereby designated as approved for use in the application to be submitted by the City in response to the competitive application process undertaken by the Department of Development of Cuyahoga County for Community Development Block Grant Program funds:

Update Audio/Video Equipment at the Richmond Heights Community Center.

Section 2: The Mayor is authorized to submit the application on behalf of the City to the Department of Development of Cuyahoga County prior to the submission deadline.


