A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BIDS FOR THE 2025 ROAD PROGRAM CONTRACT B – COUNTY PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE PROJECT-- AND CONTRACT C – MISCELLANEOUS REPAIRS PROJECT-- AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT THEREFOR WITH SPECIALIZED CONSTRUCTION, INC.

WHEREAS, pursuant to legal notice therefor, duly published according to law, four (4) sealed bids were received at the office of the Purchasing Agent of the City of Richmond Heights for labor and materials for the 2025 Road Program Contract B – County Preventative Maintenance Project-- and for the 2025 Road Program Contract C – Miscellaneous Repairs Project-- in accordance with specifications prepared by the City Engineer and on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent;

WHEREAS, pursuant thereto, the lowest and best bid received for said labor and materials for the 2025 Road Program Contract B – County Preventative Maintenance Project-- as recommended by the City Engineer, is:

Specialized Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$185,615.00.

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid received for said labor and materials for the 2025 Road Program Contract C – Miscellaneous Repairs Project as recommended by the City Engineer, is:

Specialized Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$106,455.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The bid for labor and materials for the 2025 Road Program Contract B – County Preventative Maintenance Project-- and the bid for labor and materials for the 2025 Road Program Contract C – Miscellaneous Repairs Project-- as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution, are each accepted by this Council as the lowest and best bid therefor and the Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized to execute a contract in the amount of said bids with Specialized Construction, Inc. in accordance with this Council's appropriation therefor.

Section 2: The funds necessary for payment of the contract authorized in Section 1 hereof shall come from Fund# 410-6450-52450.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
