

City of Richmond Heights Park Rules

Parks are open from dawn to dusk unless otherwise posted or authorized by the City of Richmond Heights.

Pets may be walked through City parks but must be on a leash at all times. Leash shall be no greater than eight feet. Pets and its owner must be registered with the Police Department.

All other City ordinances with respect to vicious animals and the removal of animal excrement must be obeyed.

Removal of any City property is prohibited.

Cutting, picking or destruction of plant life or property is prohibited.

Parking is allowed in designated areas only. No parking on the grass, gravel or other surface not specifically designated as a parking area.

Household and/or commercial garbage dumping is prohibited.

Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.

Golfing and skateboarding are prohibited.

All fireworks are prohibited.

When driving in the City Parks, motorists must obey the posted speed limits.

Park playground equipment is for children 12 years old and younger. Toddler swings are for children 3 years old and younger.

The Recreation Department must be contacted at (216) 383-6313, if having an event with over 30 people.

Please dispose of trash in the appropriate containers.

Please refrain from using profanity.

Music must not disturb other park patrons.

No person shall release an arrow from a bow, crossbow or longbow within any park.

No person shall establish or maintain any camp or temporary lodging or sleeping place within any park.

No person shall operate within the parks a go-kart, swamp buggy, snowmobile or any other motor vehicle which is not customarily registered with the Registrar of Motor Vehicles of the State.
