**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FROM THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS FOR A PROJECT TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE NORTHEAST OHIO AREAWIDE COORDINATING AGENCY TRANSPORTATION FOR A LIVABLE COMMUNITIES GRANT FOR THE CHARDON/BRUSH ROAD AREA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026.**

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA), through its Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative (TLCI) provides assistance to communities and public agencies for integrated transportation and land use planning projects that strengthen community livability;

WHEREAS, the City has been advised by NOACA that it is eligible to participate in a competitive application process for awarding of TLCI implementation projects for Fiscal Year 2026, which awards will be made for up to 80% of the total project cost and will require a minimum of a 20% local match, which may be waived or partially waived in accordance with NOACA policy;

WHEREAS, the City is permitted to submit one or more projects as part of its application, with no cap on how much funding can be requested, provided that the total budget for NOACA's TLCI competitive program is \$1,500.000;

WHEREAS, the City has determined to apply for said TLCI grant funding for an integrated transportation and land use planning project to improve the streetscape and safety of the Chardon Road/Brush Road area.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The integrated transportation and land use planning project for the Chardon Road/Brush Road area is hereby designated as approved for use in the application to be submitted by the City in response to the competitive application process undertaken by NOACA for the TLCI competitive program.

Section 2: The Mayor is authorized to submit the application on behalf of the City to NOACA prior to the submission deadline.


