

RESOLUTION NO.: 132-2007

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES' COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR A STORAGE FILING SYSTEM AND UNIT FOR THE NEW CITY HALL BUILDING.

Whereas, Council has heretofore authorized cooperative purchasing through the competitive bids obtained through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchase Program; and

Whereas, City is in need of a new storage filing system and mobile storage unit for the new City Hall building, the purchase of which can be made through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

Whereas, Council has reviewed the need for a new storage filing system and mobile storage unit and recommends the same and this Council desires to authorize the procurement of this equipment through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program from a vendor known as the Central Business Group.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to enter into an agreement with Central Business Group, for the purchase of a new storage filing system and mobile storage unit, plus installation and maintenance thereof, at a cost of \$22,281.67 under State Contract No. 7714300106 (equipment) and State Contract No. 7736400406 (installation and maintenance), as part of the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 2: The Finance Director be, and she is hereby, authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the agreement set forth in Section 1 above, which monies shall come from the Capital Fund and to be reimbursed from loan proceeds at a later date.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
