

RESOLUTION NO.: 87 -2008

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY LIBRARY
ISSUE 127 ON THE BALLOT ON NOVEMBER 4, 2008.

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Public Library has placed on the November 4, 2008 general election ballot Issue 127 which will replace 2 mills and add one half mill to the Library's annual operating budget so the Cuyahoga County Public Library can continue to serve the needs of local citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and this Council recognize that the Cuyahoga County Public Library is a critical regional resource based on service, accountability, and value to the community as it is the fifth busiest library in the nation circulating over 16 million items annually, with one half million cardholders who visited a branch library 7.2 million times last year; and

WHEREAS, libraries enrich the lives of individuals, provide critical information for students and organizations and create meaningful access to modern technology which are the primary reasons for citizens to support Issue 127; and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor and Council of the City of Richmond Heights express their strong support for the passage of Issue 127 on the November 4, 2008 ballot, and strongly urge the citizens of the City of Richmond Heights to vote favorably for the passage of the levy as the same has a direct effect upon the community by providing critical services that local citizens need.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
