

RESOLUTION NO.: 7 -2009

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO
A CONTRACT WITH SIGNAL SERVICE COMPANY FOR
SERVICE AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC CONTROL
DEVICES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights is in need of services relating to the relamping of the City's traffic signals, school signs, and warning signs, and general maintenance work of said traffic facilities; and

WHEREAS, a quotation of Signal Service Company of Warrensville Heights, Ohio, dated December 16, 2008, has been reviewed by the Chief of Police and this Council's Safety Committee and found to be reasonable;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Signal Service Company for relamping and general maintenance services pursuant to a form of contract acceptable to the Director of Law in an amount not to exceed \$8,900.00 and for the continuing replacement of cracked or broken lenses and visors for the cost of materials only on an "as needed" basis and said contract to be for the term effective December 1, 2008 through November 30, 2010.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Richmond Heights for the reason that it is necessary to provide such relamping and general maintenance services for the safety of pedestrian and motor vehicle traffic in the City on an ongoing basis and without interruption, and, therefore,

this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
