

ORDINANCE NO. : 32 -2009
INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Ursu and Council

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PAY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY TO AUTHORIZE ONE PERSON TO FILL THE POSITION OF ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER OF BUILDING, ZONING AND HOUSING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council has determined to provide for one person to fill the position of Assistant Commissioner of Building, Zoning and Housing;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Existing Section 8A. of Ordinance 107-2008, the Pay Ordinance of the City, be, and the same is hereby, amended to authorize one person to fill the position of Assistant Commissioner of Building, Zoning and Housing, which shall hereafter read as follows:

A. The employees of the Building Department shall receive the following compensation in accordance with the Schedule of Pay Scale for a work week of 40 hours:

SEx 1 - Assistant Commissioner of Building, Zoning and Housing	\$25,309-\$68,500 per annum (2007)
	\$25,309-\$70,555 per annum (2008)
	\$36,689-\$73,377 per annum (2009)

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Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public safety and general welfare of the City, and for the further reason that there is a need to fill the position of Assistant Commissioner of Building, Zoning and Housing, on or about July 1, 2009 due to the retirement of the current Commissioner of Building, Zoning and Housing by that date and the need for an interim manager of said Division. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of five members of the Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
