**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CONTRACT WITH A&J CEMENT
CONTRACTORS FOR THE CITY'S 2009 ROAD PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 25-2009 of this Council, a contract was authorized with A&J Cement Contractors for Sections II and IIA of the 2009 Road Program bid specifications in the amount of \$110,854.50; and

WHEREAS, upon commencement of the cement work for the 2009 Road Program by A&J Cement Contractors, it was determined by the City Engineer that certain design changes were necessary in roadway areas for proper drainage and such changes necessitated additional quantities under the subject contract in the amount of \$9,846.23; and

WHEREAS, the overall expense for work under the 2009 Road Program contracts, Sections I through IVA, has been well under the total authorized amounts for those contracts and, therefore, the amendment to the A&J Cement Contractors contract for additional quantities and work of \$9,846.23 will be more than offset by the savings achieved from the other contractors' reduced compensation for the Road Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The contract authorized for A&J Cement Contractors for Sections II and IIA of the 2009 Road Program is authorized to be amended so that the maximum authorized contract price of \$110,854.50 is increased by \$9,846.23 to a total of \$120,700.73; and the Mayor and the Director of Finance of the City are authorized and directed to execute and enter into on behalf of the City a proper amendment to said contract.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the costs of the amendment to the contract set forth in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in

compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
